

Guidelines and Mechanics of the ASEAN Quiz

1. The quiz will be held on October 11, 2024, at 1:30 PM at the Ivatan Conference Hall and is open to both Junior and Senior High School students from public and private schools within the division.
2. Each school is allotted three (3) contestants, except for Batanes National Science High School, which is allotted four (4) contestants.
3. Each school shall strategize on how to identify their respective participants ensuring equal opportunity for all learners.
4. Qualified contestants from each school must be accompanied by one (1) teacher-coach, who will serve as their mentor throughout the competition.
5. The final list of participants must be submitted to Jay V. Gonzales, EPS-AP on or before October 1, 2024.
6. The scope of the quiz will be:
 - a. History and Formation of ASEAN
 - b. ASEAN Organizations and Agreements
 - c. ASEAN Initiatives and Programs
 - d. ASEAN and Global Relations
7. There shall be three rounds – EASY, AVERAGE, and DIFFICULT with 10, 7, and 5 questions respectively. The EASY round shall be equivalent to 1 point, 2 points for the AVERAGE round, and 3 points for the DIFFICULT round.
8. Questions will be read twice by the quizmaster. Only when he/she gives the “GO” signal can the contestants start writing their answers on the paper provided to them. When the quizmaster says “STOP”, contestants must raise their pens after which, proctors/watchers will verify their answer whether it is correct or wrong and be indicated in the score sheet.
9. After the third round, the points of each contestant will be added. The top five (5) contestants who garnered the highest points will be declared as First Place, Second Place, Third Place, Fourth Place, and Fifth Place.
10. Cash Prize and Certificate of Recognition will be awarded to the top 5 winners. A Certificate of Participation will also be given to other participants and coaches. The cash prizes will be as follows:

First place	1,500
Second Place	1,300
Third Place	1,100
Fourth Place	900
Fifth Place	700
