STUDENT-LED SCHOOL WATCHING AND HAZARD MAPPING

1. Incompliance with DO 23, s. 2015, titled, **Student- Led School Watching and Hazard Mapping**. This strengthens disaster preparedness, prevention, and mitigation, and one of the key strategies to address the vulnerabilities of children inside and outside the school. With the increasing effects of Climate Change, it is important to raise the awareness and capacities of children to prepare for and manage possible disaster and / or emergencies.
2. Moreover, all schools should conduct Hazard Mapping to improve students' level of awareness on the potential hazards and risk within and around school, Increase the participation of children in addressing potential disasters by reducing vulnerabilities and inculcate a culture of safety in the day-to-day experience of children in school.
3. In this connection, the Division DRRM Coordinator will conduct monitoring this third and fourth weeks of September on Hazard Map, Early Warning System and Hotline Numbers of Line Agencies preferably put in the DRRM Bulletin Board located in a Conspicuous place in the school and in the classrooms ready reference of learners during time of emergencies.
4. All School Heads should coordinate with their respective DRRM Focal Person to comply with these requirements.
