1. In line with the Department of Education's (DepEd) commitment to ensuring equitable access to education for all learners, especially those at risk of dropping out, as outlined in DM-CT-2024-030 titled "*Guidelines on the Utilization and Reporting of the Program Support Funds for the Alternative Delivery Mode for Fiscal Year 2024*," the Schools Division of Batanes, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID), will conduct a **Training-Workshop on the Development of Project Proposals for ADM School-Initiated Intervention (SII)** on October 5-6, 2024, starting at 8:00 AM at the Ivatan Conference Hall.
2. The activity aims to:
 - a. equip participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to develop comprehensive and well-structured project proposals for school-initiated interventions under the Alternative Delivery Mode (ADM).

 - c. foster collaboration and sharing of best practices among school leaders in promoting the success of ADM programs in their respective schools.
 - d. provide participants with a platform to submit feasible project proposals that will secure necessary support and resources for implementation.
3. Participants are advised to bring their laptops and extension cords. Meals and snacks will be charged against ADM Funds while travel expenses of the participant will be charged against School MOOE subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.


