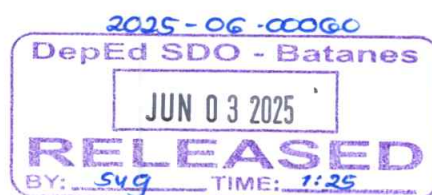

Subject: **ONLINE TRAINING ON THE STRENGTHENED SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL CURRICULUM FOR GRADE 11 TEACHERS OF PILOT SCHOOLS**

1. Pursuant to Memorandum DM-OUHROD-2025-1307 from the Department of Education Central Office, the Schools Division of Batanes hereby informs all concerned of the **Online Training on the Strengthened Senior High School (SHS) Curriculum** to be conducted by the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), in partnership with the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) and the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD), on **June 4-5, 2025** via Microsoft Teams.
2. This training aims to capacitate Grade 11 teachers of pilot schools, specifically **Mahatao National High School (MNHS)** and **Itbud Integrated School (IIS)**, in delivering core subjects and academic/technical-professional electives under the Strengthened SHS Curriculum. The sessions will cover various subjects including:
 - General Mathematics

In reference to the Memorandum DM-OUHROD-2025-1307, titled *Training on the Strengthened Senior High School (SHS) Curriculum Training for Teachers of Pilot Schools*, dated 22 May 2025, the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP), in collaboration with the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD) and the Bureau of Learning Delivery (BLD), will be conducting a **Webinar Series on the Strengthened SHS Curriculum on June 4–5, 2025**.

This training aims to equip Grade 11 teachers with the necessary knowledge, pedagogical strategies, and curriculum standards to deliver quality instruction aligned with the Strengthened SHS Curriculum. It is intended for teachers who will handle core subjects, as well as those who will teach electives under the Academic and Technical Professional Tracks. The sessions will cover the following areas:

- Life and Career Skills
- Pag-aaral ng Kasaysayan at Lipunang Pilipino

- An Overview of Technical Professional (TechPro) Electives

Teachers from pilot schools who were unable to attend the face-to-face training are highly encouraged to participate in this online session. Private schools identified as pilot schools are likewise invited to participate.

Participants who complete the full session, including pre-registration, pre-test, post-test, and evaluation form, will earn 0.5 service credit or half-day service credit for each relevant session attended. An e-certificate of participation will also be provided.

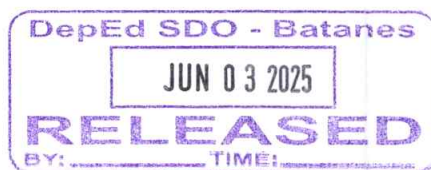

GENERAL WEBINAR DECORUM FOR PARTICIPANTS

*Online Training on the Strengthened Senior High School Curriculum for Grade 11

June 4-5, 2025 | MS Teams*

- ✓ **Join on Time** – Log in a few minutes before the scheduled start to avoid disruptions and catch important announcements.
- ✓ **Use Your Real Name** – Use your full name (and designation if required) for identification and professional interaction.
- ✓ **Mute Your Microphone** – Keep your mic muted unless you are speaking to minimize background noise.
- ✓ **Turn on Camera** (if appropriate) – If the setting encourages it, keep your camera on to show engagement, but ensure you are presentable, and your background is tidy.
- ✓ **Dress Appropriately** – Wear professional or business-casual attire, especially if your camera is on.
- ✓ **Minimize Distractions** – Stay in a quiet space, avoid multitasking, and silence notifications.
- ✓ **Be Respectful in Chat** – Use polite language, avoid all caps (shouting), and don't spam the chat with off-topic questions or emojis.
- ✓ **Engage Actively** – Take notes, respond to polls, and participate in Q&A sessions appropriately.
- ✓ **Use "Raise Hand" Feature** – If you want to speak or ask a question verbally, use the platform's "raise hand" function or follow the host's directions.
- ✓ **Respect Time** – Keep questions and comments concise and relevant to the topic.
