PRIDE MONTH CELEBRATION AND DIGITAL GAD LOGO MAKING CONTEST


To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent Chief Education Supervisors SDO Unit Heads and Staff Elementary and Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

 - d. Showcasing learner talents through original songs, poems, posters, or other forms of creative expression promoting PRIDE values;
 - e. Featuring stories of acceptance and respect in school newsletters, journals, or class presentations.

Theme	"Embracing Diversity and Advancing Inclusion in Schools"		
Format	Digital format in Scalable Vector Graphic (SVG) and Portable Network Graphics (PNG). Entries must include a short description or rationale of the logo design in Word Format. File name/s: [School/Office Name] GAD-Logo-Entry2025 [Artist Name]		
Submission Deadline	All entries must be submitted on or before June 23, 2025		
Submission Details	Entries must be submitted to the Human Resource Development Section (HRDS) through the email address: hrd.batanes@deped.gov.ph		


Criteria for Judging

Criteria	Description	Rate
Relevance to the Theme	The logo clearly reflects the principles, goals, and essence of Gender and Development. It should convey inclusivity, equality, and empowerment of all genders	30%
Creativity and Originality	The design demonstrates unique and innovative ideas. Avoid the use of generic or plagiarized design elements.	25%
Visual Impact	The overall appearance is striking and memorable. The logo is eye-catching and effectively attracts attention	20%
Simplicity and Clarity	The logo is simple enough to be easily recognizable and understood at a glance. Clean and uncluttered design.	15%
Technical Quality	Proper use of colors, balance, spacing and composition	10%
