4. Likewise, all completed research output should also be submitted in AIMRAD Format aside from the localized format both in hard and soft copies.
5. Failure to comply this requirement shall require the BERF Research proponent/s to write a letter of explanation addressed to the Regional Research Technical Working Group. For Non-BERF research proponents, non-submission on the said period means disapproval of certification of completion.
