**2023 CELEBRATION OF NATIONAL TEACHERS' MONTH AND WORLD'S
TEACHERS' DAY**

1. Pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 242 titled, ***Declaring the Period from September 5 to October 5 of Every Year as "National Teachers' Month"*** and in consonance with the celebration of "World Teachers' Day" on October 5, 2023, as designated by the United Nations Education and Cultural Organization (UNESCO), ***this Office hereby enjoins all Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools to launch the National Teachers' Month on September 5, 2023.*** Additionally, we urge the schools to organize various activities to celebrate and honor our dedicated teachers during this period.
2. The Celebration aims to:
 - a. Honor those who are in the teaching profession;
 - b. Acknowledge and give emphasis on the crucial role, loyal service, and dedicated commitment of teachers in developing globally minded citizens, nurturing families, strengthening communities, and building the nation;
 - c. Revitalize the image of and respect for teaching as a vocation by increasing public awareness on the value of teachers in the Philippine society;
 - d. Take the occasion as an opportunity in building the image of teaching as an attractive and fulfilling profession;
 - e. Generate widespread support and assistance for teachers; and
 - f. Express gratitude for the positive influences of teachers on Filipino learners
3. All public and private elementary and secondary schools in this division are enjoined to follow the synchronized programs, projects, and activities (SPPAs).

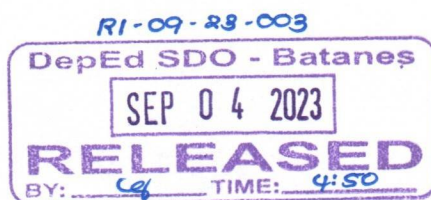
